**QUALIFICATIONS:**

Age, 31. Born in Mendocino County, he came to Humboldt with his family in 1915. He has resided in Eureka for the past four years. Received his education at Humboldt State and at the University of California where he studied economics and business administration.

Employed at the Standard Oil Home Office in San Francisco, Lima served in the capacity of Ass't Hall Boy Supervisor, training new workers. There he had 1½ years experience in bookkeeping and accounting.

Lima is familiar with the Ordinances of the City of Eureka, having worked in the City Hall on a WPA project, rewriting, revising and reindexing the Ordinances. He drew up a new license ordinance which would have eliminated the inequalities existing in the present one, but which was turned down by the Mayor.

Believing that strong trade unions are the best guarantee of preserving democratic government, Lima has been active in union affairs, having helped organize several locals of the lumber workers and the Workers Alliance.

Lima has been a member of the Communist Party since 1936.

## WHY THE COMMUNIST PARTY ENTERS THE EUREKA CITY ELECTION CAMPAIGN

There are two main reasons for the Communist Party, Eureka Branch, entering the city elections this year.

1. To clarify the issues confronting the voters of Eureka, to point out who is blocking progress, and to explain what is necessary to build a better Eureka.
2. To acquaint the people with the role of the Communist Party, through its activities in the election campaign, and to show conclusively that the Communists have no interest separate and apart from the welfare and progress of the people.

### INDEPENDENT ROLE

The Eureka Branch of the Communist Party presents its own program to end monopoly corruption of city government and for building a better Eureka, based on the needs of Eureka's working people, small businessmen, professionals and home owners. It has its own candidate, Albert J. "Mickie" Lima, who is a candidate for City Council from the 5th Ward.

### RED BAITING

As the date of elections approaches, the old "red herring" may be dragged out in an effort to sow confusion and defeat those candidates who would best serve the people of Eureka, instead of the corporate interests. Whisper campaigns may be started, or fake publicity issued, to create the impression that certain other candidates are endorsed by the Communist Party.

Last year, that happened in the County elections in one Supervisorial District.

Red baiting is an old game for defeating the interests of the people, and it can be combatted only by pointing out the reasons behind it, not by becoming panic stricken by it.

Remember: Albert J. "Mickie" Lima is the only candidate endorsed by the Communist Party.

## FOR SOCIAL AND NATIONAL SECURITY

Since the betrayal of democratic Czechoslovakia by the sell-out of Chamberlain and Daladier, since the defeat of democratic Spain by the invasion of German and Italian Fascists with the aid of Chamberlain and Daladier, our country has come face to face with the danger of encroaching Fascism.

"Confessions of a Nazi Spy", which just concluded a four day run at the Eureka Theater was a documentary portrayal of the activities of Fascists within our organs of defense.

Today two countries stand out in the front-line in defense of Democracy, two countries with no conflicting interests and with common enemies --the United States and the Soviet Union. Our government has taken the lead in exposing the war aims of the Fascists. It is to the national interests of our country that our government go forward to a mutual understanding with the one constant defender of the democracies, with the one country which has a positive and constant peace policy, the one country which has steadfastly stood by its treaties, the Soviet Union.

Today, in California, the Department of Justice is carrying on a sweeping investigation of the Associated Farmers and its vigilante anti-labor activities. Nazi spy and sabotage activities in California airplane factories are also being investigated.

In Eureka, the task of the progressive people is to elect into office those who will protect and defend the democratic rights of the people of our community.

Our program is designed to protect the interests of the people of our community. Our party brings its program to you, for Social and National Security, for unity of all progressive forces, for the elimination of Monopoly Control of City Government, for Building a Better Eureka.

# A PROGRAM FOR THE PEOPLE

## I. FOR THE YOUNG PEOPLE:

Recreational Centers and Swimming Pool

## II. FOR THE HOME OWNER AND SMALL BUSINESS MAN:

More equitable taxation and license fees.

## III. FOR LABOR:

The fundamental rights of labor--to organize, to strike, and to picket--to be guaranteed without police interference and brutality. Union wages for all city employees. WPA projects for the unemployed.

## IV. GENERAL IMPROVEMENTS FOR EUREKA:

Modern transportation system, sidewalk and street improvement, and adequate sewage and drainage systems, through use of PWA and WPA grants, for lowest possible cost to taxpayers.

## V. STOP MONOPOLY CORRUPTION OF CITY GOVERNMENT:

Public investigation of Mad River Dam project, and complete report to the people of Eureka on costs, lack of filter system, reservoir, etc. Enforce Ordinance #331 which sets ground rental rate of 10¢ per pole per year for telephone and electric poles. Stop favoritism to large corporations who are best able to pay.
