Cook and Green Pass is located near the Oregon border in Siskiyou County (41.942 N, 123.146 W; USGS Kangaroo Mountain Quadrangle). The pass itself is at 4816 feet. Seiad Valley is probably the closest community. The Klamath National Forest has designated about 700 acres of the region as the Cook and Green Botanical Area in recognition of its floristic richness. Here we find "... the largest single aggregation of native plant species known to occur in one limited area in California" (Roof 1975).
