About This Journal

CouRaGeouS Cuentos is a journal that includes the creative writing of students in classes offered by the Department of Critical Race, Gender & Sexuality Studies. The journal is available both in digital commons at: digitalcommons.humboldt.edu/courageouscuentos/ and as a printed, bound copy available through Amazon.com.

The works published in this journal are by students in *Ethnic Studies 107: Chican@/Latinx Lives* and students in *Ethnic Studies 480: Growing Up Chicana/Latino*. The students want to make their stories, their counternarratives, available to their families, their communities, and any other students who could relate to their stories.

The journal is published annually with the creative written works by students in the spring and fall semesters of each calendar year. The editing of the works is a collective effort by students in the class, students in *Ethnic Studies 280: Courageous Cuentos Production*, and the instructors of *Chican@/Latinx Lives* and *Growing Up Chicana/Latino*. Every student in the class has the opportunity to publish their work and do so on a voluntary basis. Some students submit more than one entry in addition to a reflection on their own writing process.
