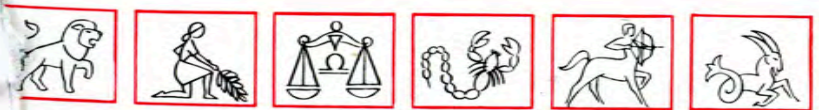

1979 33rd day - 332 days follow

Went to Eureka to get 2 silver spoons,
ordered in mid-December.

Took things to Beeky around 4:30.
make a meatloaf as soon as Bill
got home.

Scott Williams arrived - would be in
area until Sunday.



up early to get ready to go 1979 34th day - 331 days follow
hiking with Merna Outhrie. Left at 10 in
cool sunshine. Lovely morning. Drove
to Gold Bluffs beach, left Toyota there;
rode back to mouth of Redwood Creek with
Merna. Left car at 11:20, 40 minutes to
Mussel Point, clambered over and around
wet rocks at low tide (12:00) - no problem.
Stopped for lunch about 12:30. It took
less than 15 minutes to get around point.
Had about one mile (only) of remote beach
without wheel tracks. Clouds began to in-
crease, but it remained comfortable.

Ended walk at 1:40. 20-25 min. back to Otter
Creek. Merna stopped at house to look at
books & maps.

Bill at school to survey for any earth
quake damage to culture lab.

Went to North Group Ex Con at Van Kirk's

1979 35th day - 330 days follow The house rocked once, then
again, awakening me at 2 AM. Plant overhead swaying
for prolonged time. Tom & Biel "down under" reported
things on shelves close to dislodging. Scott, up and
ready to go outside! Somewhat scare-y!
Up by 8. 37°F. Variable cloudiness.

Watched Trinidad to Clam Beach
annual running event - from neighbor's
deck. Few removed shoes to cross low
tide, shallow, Little River. Somewhere
from 6-8 hundred participated.

Bill Devall and a friend stopped by
later. He completed run, but not
in competing time - 8½ miles - 42 minutes,
this year's top time. Last year's winner, 40 min.

Bill worked at replacing boards on west
deck.

Bill & Tom left for ¹⁹⁷⁹ 36th day - 329 days follow
campus ^{Lincoln's Birthday (Monday observance)} 7:20. They got away
about 9:30 (after I trimmed his hair).
Cloudy, and later drizzly.

Went to Redwood National Park offices
in Jacoby Storehouse, Arcata, to get a

Variable cloudiness. Warm, lovely day.

Tom put final coat of paint on ceiling. Typed rough draft of Chapter Ex Com minutes to be forwarded to Dennis Shutz for content to go into next Needles.

Decided NOT to attend Friends of Del Norte pathless (annual) meeting as too early in day for me to arrange for - with a deadline on Chapter materials.

Tom took off on bicycle for time with friends in Trinidad, returning late evening.

Bill Devall came out for dinner with me; to look at slides of Hwy-101 project near Leggett and try to reach some conclusions to comment to Caltrans.

Wonderful sunbathing day. Bill phoned from Yellow Bay in early evening. Sounded good - and busy - on research.

Jim bed early.

Up before 6.

Very cloudy. Very warm. 1979 190th day - 175 days follow

Went to Eureka by 11 - to talk to Don La Faunce at Fish & Game about the viaduct project.

Heavy rain began around noon. Took mail to Iris around 1:30. Home for late lunch at 2:20.

Tom busy on phone re. Shelter Cove - no painting today.

Sent Exlom (draft) minutes off to Dennis Lantz and Dave Luckhardt; also did some Xeroxing for Tom.

Cassie phoned (10 p.m.) from Iris'. She, Trick and Mandy (Don's girl friend) on way home after week in Oregon with Helen and family.

TUESDAY

JULY

1979 191st day - 174 days follow

Variable cloudiness. Up by 6:40. Typed up letter to Coastal Conservancy re. Eureka Water-front project being considered. Mailed letter in Eureka before 5.

Beautiful day.

1979 192nd day - 173 days follow

Prepared to leave for Crescent City by noon for Regional Coastal Com. meeting at 2. Stopped in Orick for shuttle bus tickets from park headquarters (for Sine Club outing Saturday, Sunday.)

Meeting ended around 6 p.m. Ron Greenblatt arrived (via hiking trip in Oregon). He accepted invitation to join me for dinner and to spend night in Klamath Glen at Greg's place.

Dinner at local "Steelhead Bobs" looking out onto massive Klamath levee mound! However, good steak dinner.

Mike Brackner, Greg's co-worker friend, who will "do" Grande Ronde river trip with us, came over to talk about plans. We were up until 1 a.m.

Ron had bedded down by ten, tired from bus trip.

Tapped up comments on Cathlamet Leggett viaduct project. (Delivered in person at Coastal Com. meeting).

1979 193rd day - 172 days follow

Breakfast near Tree of Mystery at 8. Meeting began again in Crescent City at 9 a.m. Gorgeous day. Ocean choppy from gusty winds. The Commissioners worked through noon hour - adjourned around 1:30.

The Humboldt County LRP was presented. I spoke on the Land Use Standards and Policies as a CAC member.

After lunch in CC, Ron and I drove around area to view some project sites - one near Oregon line east of Lily bulb farms; one in a marshy area near Lake Earl.

Back to Moonstone by 6:30. Made a large mixed green salad for dinner.

Tom went to Eureka "for the ride" when I took Ron to Greyhound depot to return to Fort Bragg via Weavert.

Tom and I played cribbage.

Beautiful day. Warm. 1979 194th day - 171 days follow
Went to Arata to get a few things
for overnight backpack trip.

Tom worked on Shelter cone
materials - lots of phone calls.
Gave him a ride to Arata at
2:30. Took mail to Iris -
Home by 4:15.

Also took large load of re-
cyclable items to Arata's center.

Went to Becky's around 5.

Talked with Mena ^{re} total number
of hikers going into Redwood Creek.

^{Lovely morning.} Mena
arrived before 9. 5 of us going on Redwood
Creek hike. Shuttle bus took us over
first main creek road to CLW5 (a variation
to leave car in safe place overnight), then
to Tall Trees trail. 1 mile walk to Tall
Trees Grove - lovely now on old jeep route.
A Polish gentleman joined us to that point,
then hiked out same day.

We put packs on gravel bar just upstream
from Tall Trees Grove, then headed for Bridge
Creek, via old overgrown road. Fought
brush and heavy growth for 2.4 miles.

Bridge Creek mouth clear of old debris now.
Park Service not using the old trail, it seems.
Cris - crossed the stream (in boots) for
walk back to "camp" over gravel bars.
Saw some beautiful swimming holes.
A few groups camped out for the
night.

Everyone folded early - before
dark - all good and tired.

Awake at daybreak with 1979 196th day - 169 days follow

calls from ravens, herons, varied Thrushes, Stellers jays, sparrows and other birds. Fog cleared early, 8:30 or so. First up.

1979 197th day - 168 days follow

Low fog/clouds - Warm. Rick Thoreson + Tom left for Eureka at 9:30. Greg left soon after.

Made appt. at Stanford Medical Center Sept 6: surgery, the 10th. Phoned Bill at Yellow Bay, so he could make plans.

Took Tom to airport by 3. Greg returned for dinner.

Phoned Bill at Yellow Bay at noon to relay hospital plans for September.

Sun out around Anate, but no clearing at Hoanstone all day.

Bill Devall came by awhile. Greg returned for dinner. We both did some reading and writing - and talking about river trip. In bed by 11:00.

Mostly overcast all day. ¹⁹⁷⁹ 198th day - 167 days follow
Warm - no wind.

Started some laundry work after Peg left - about 8:45 - to do errands in Eureka & Arcata.

Went to Eureka before 10. Got dash glasses frame repaired, then shopped for shirts and shorts.

Home by 2:30 after brief stops in Arcata and a cup of coffee with Lee and Dix.

Caught up on papers, mail, etc.

Went to CAC meeting, 7:30, at Courthouse. Home by 11:30. Next CAC Aug. 1.

Picked up wire trip ^{needed} equipment.
Ordered 4 drawer unfinished dresser at Paint 'n Place in Eureka.

1979 199th day - 166 days follow

Overcast. Warm.
Finished laundry work; and did some housecleaning.

Tried to locate Alan Ardizzone and Jessie, but they had just headed south, bicycles atop a car, it was learned.

Phone call from Jean Hagood re. many things!

1979 200th day - 165 days follow

worked on Coastal Appeal.

1979 201st day - 164 days follow

Spent morning preparing gear for river trip and taking care of last minute conservation deadlines. Mailed Coastal appeal on a Del Norte project.

Took things to Becky before 3:30.

Drove to Del Norte Conservation Center to add my things to Guy's car, then over to Patrick and Donna's to leave the Toyota. Michael (Brashears) was ready to leave by 6.

We stopped at Patrick's Creek Resort for dinner, which was leisurely, then drove on to the McKenzie River Highway east of Springfield, Oregon, a few miles (gasoline tank low) to a wayside. Threw our sleeping bags out around 1:30 a.m.

Michael relieved Greg at the wheel. I rode in back seat of the VW "Rabbit" surrounded by duffel bags. Managed to stay comfortable enough to fall asleep once in awhile. We had music via cassettes to help out in the late hours.

Clear and quite "starry bright".

Awake early. Leg hurting. 1979 202nd day - 163 days follow

Wandered around the rapids until Greg & Mike began to stir. Found gasoline a few miles on, and a good restaurant (Waltersville, I think, or Leaburg. lovely drive along river. Ran into misty clouds over pass, then broke into sunshine. Stopped to view the lava beds and mountains. Photographed flames at lovely ranch near Redmond.

Went to Madras. Very hot, but odor of watered mint fields made it tolerable. Had a hamburger and milkshake there. Arrived at boat launch place on Deschutes River near Maupin at 2.

All our gang there arranging gear. Very hot. Changed from jeans to cut-offs.

Water borne at 3 from put in spot about 1 1/2 miles upstream (below Sherar's Falls) from Maupin.

Connie had Greg, Mike, Diane and Snuffy, the year old Springer Spaniel. Gary had in his boat - Melissa (13), Jessica, (9), nephew of Gary's "J.E.T." and me.

The 3 cars would be shuttled to the Columbia on the 28th.

River cool and green, flowing about 4 mi. per hr. Banks lined with shade trees. We camped a few miles downstream, only on water less than an hour.

1979 203rd day - 162 days follow

Lovely morning. Train tracks almost overhead, so very close views of long, 80-100 cars, freight trains.

Took our time getting ready to move on. Very warm, so we only went downstream to Cedar Island, which we re-named "Birthday" Island. Connie, Greg and Mike all with July birthdays.

Good river rapids here for going on inner tube or in life jackets. Some (Gary, Mike, JET) went fishing.

Reading, playing, resting, order of the day. Mike barbecued great chunk of rib eye steak - We had cocktails and then champagne. A creek ran across the Island. A sandy patch at river edge to sleep on. Some were on a grassy plot. Melissa & Jessica put up a tent.

We saw eagles in late day. Heard many birds - identified all but 2.

Mike & I even played a game of cribbage. Everyone happy here. Good views of the long freight trains - Took many photos.

Birchbark story skinsack night.

1979 204th day - 161 days follow

Gary and I explored around island before breakfast, trying to take a cup of coffee to Michael on far side - fishing. We even tried a very fishy "dip" at 8 a.m.! Much too cold to swim - so early.

A lazy, fun day for everyone. Several rafting parties went by.

Did a lot of bird watching. Extremely warm afternoons, so I've huddled near the tree shaded boats.

All agreed we should remain on Birthday Island another night. Had more wonderful Steads, but cooked quite differently - served with rice and other goodies.

Viewed a lot of turkey vultures in late day.

1979 205th day - 160 days follow

Planned to move on after breakfast, before it got too hot.

Next stop was a tricky one - very fast water - another island. We took left channel and pulled into shaded right bank. Boats had to be pulled up at steep angle.

Went to other side of island for swimming in less swift water. The girls played on inner tubes - Others went fishing - or some took up their books.

I bird watched mostly after a cooling dip.

Several of us slept on the sage brush and blackberry flat to be out under the stars. Wonderful odor of sage all around.

No hiking available from here, so we contented ourselves with various pastimes, including identifying plants.

Went on downstream ¹⁹⁷⁹ 206th day - 159 days follow
to Macks Canyon. BLM has placed
chemical toilet here. Old abandoned
track on easy grade on right ^(east) side
of river.

Did a lot of swimming, fishing,
reading, bird-watching here. Nice
camp. Water comfortable to stay in
long periods of time. A few
jet boats went by.

Saw 2 red-tailed hawks. many
vultures, goldfinches, swallows.

Diana and Mike saw an
otter when they went upstream with
inner tubes.

Greg and I hiked to Dry Creek
canyon, about 1 mile, in late
afternoon along old railbed. Photos.

Found old spikes. Met Diana
and Jessica on our return. Had to
keep alert for rattlesnakes.

The girls had popcorn (over camp
fire).

Again, slept away from river
in the sage brush flat just
up slope a bit.

¹⁹⁷⁹ 207th day - 158 days follow

JET went rock
hunting and found some guppies.
Again we moved downstream
before heat set in. Much river
traffic, both rafters and jet boats.

Found a place to stop that was
less than ideal. on west side, very
narrow, right under the railroad tracks.
We named it Spider Hollow or Camp
of the Spiders. Spiders, all shapes
sizes and colors, dominated the area.

Greg heard a rattlesnake very
close to camp, so we all kept
alert. A desert "view" with a few
cattle on opposite shore.

Had a popcorn feast - again
over campfire - just before
"sack"-time.

Everyone, except JET, who slept in
a boat, was huddled close,
on the sloping campsite. Not
the greatest place!

Trains were almost too close.
The earth rumbled as they
creaked by us in the night.

Glad to get underway ¹⁹⁷⁹ 208th day - 157 days follow again. Lonely drifting down-stream. Pulled into area of old homestead. Explored a bit. Very hot, dry, and deserted looking, although place well built and apparently occupied until early 1950's.

Ran the Colorado Rapid - which has a great standing wave in mid-stream.

Made camp in a lush meadow area on east bank - A few cattle here, but no problem.

Good shade and a narrow sandy beach for pulling in boats.

Fats of rafters going through. Our gassy inner-tubed off and on. I went in water to cool off.

Did a lot of sunbathing.

Another campfire and popcorn. but of propane. but of liquor.

We all found level places to sleep to make up for last night.

In bed at dark.

Awake to a jet boat at 5:50. More followed. 10 fishermen in sight upstream. Cool this morning; jacket felt good.

Only six miles to take out. Leisurely about packing up. First rapid was channelized in low lying lava "flats" and tufts of reeds. Very lovely, different, and challenging to the oarsman.

Moody rapids, the last one, was exciting - Arrived 11:30 at take out landing. BLM doing river use survey. Many jet boat and rafts arrived after us. No sign of the cars! We waited 2 hrs. in dusty wind.

Dianne went on to Joseph for weekend. We expected to spend evening with the Williams, but they left us at The Dalles and headed back to Seattle.

We 3 Took a motel. Got showered and changed clothes - Went out early for cocktails and dinner. All of us ate Fleaks!

Greg + Michael went to a movie. Fell asleep watching TV after phoning Bill, and then Tom, to let him know when I'd get home.

Breakfast at 8:00. 1979 210th day - 155 days follow

Drove Scenic drives (old highway) to high viewpoints. Mt. Rainier clear to the north. [PHOTO STOPS]. Drove Mt. Hood highway to Timberline Lodge - Bright and sunny and lots of tourists.

Great views of both Mt. Hood + Rainier. "Toured" the massive lodge, now an Historical Landmark. Had lunch there around 12:15. Drove on to (hot) Madras. Bought booklet on Deschutes River at a sporting goods store. On to [hot] Bend; a quick stop for ice cream + cold drinks. Got gasoline before heading westerly toward Crater Lake. Drove to Diamond Lake - Cocktails and dinner - very leisurely.

Then sleeping bag out on a cleared area off a side road in Rogue National Forest - at 9:30 - just getting dark - off the highway to Bend and/or Grants Pass.

Beautiful, clear, starfilled sky.

1979 211th day - 154 days follow

Awake to noisy birds and traffic - and light - by 6. Frost on bags! Breakfast at Union Creek cafe around 8. Warm by the time we reached Gasquet. Lunch in Crescent City at 12.

We drove via Sams Valley + Lost Creek dam and along the Rogue River. Many fishermen parked along highway.

Home by 3. Once unpacked, I got cleaned up - even put on a shirt.

Tom came in with Brad around 6. I had light dinner, but Tom found something to fix for the 2 of them. They went up to Trinidad for evening. (Had a fine most of evening.)

In bed by 10:30 - after going through great pile of mail. Our trip had cost each of us around 100⁰⁰ (not counting our added luxuries of dinners + drinks en route). 70⁰⁰ each to Connie. 29⁰⁰ Travel expenses.

"P.C." acted "silly" when she decided to accept me again.

Tom + Doug met with Harbor Commissioners in afternoon.

Overcast most of day 1979 212th day - 153 days follow

Social Security and Withholding Tax Return Due

Sun came through around 6:30.

Awoke early - up by 7 because my leg was hurting.

Did a lot of cleaning up of gear. Took care of some phone calls which were messages Tom took.

Went to Acata to leave film, go to P.O. for Sierra Club mail, TEEZ in Lucla for new woven wood shade for living room, back to Acata for groceries, then to Iris' to leave bills to be paid. Also, picked up Bill's mail on campus.

Took groceries and mail to Becky around 6.

Paid \$1.02 per gallon for unleaded gas (fuel ^{and} service) in Trinidad.

Bill phoned 7 p.m. from Yellow Bay. Tom busy with surfing friends.

Planning problems arising near Centerville and Trinidad.

1979 213th day - 152 days follow

Foggy, A.M.
Spent most of day getting room in order for putting rug down when ready Friday. Went to Acata after ~~Bill~~ phoned taking a package and water to Becky - around 11.

Nil in afternoon.

Went into Eureka for 7:30 CAC meeting at Court house. Home by 11:45. Clear and starry.

Foggy until after 1979 214th day - 151 days follow
lunch. Worked around house.

Bill phoned early regarding
September dates for Stanford Univ.
Hospital.

Went to Eureka after lunch to get
new typewriter and file cabinet.

Tom busy on Shelter Cove issue.

Went to 6:30 planning commission
