1st day - 364 days follow

New Year's Day

Up at 7:15. Cloudy. Drove Dave's car back to him around 8 and had breakfast with Greg then - once checking out The Eatery which was tightly closed. Greg got away for Seattle around 10, but would be driving only to Caswell's this day. Raining when he left.

Dave and I watched Rose Parade, then the entire Rose Bowl game, after part of the Copper Bowl game.

Went home by 5:30 so Tim McKay could pick up Falcon, to get to bed earliest at Ferndale by 8 a.m. He and Chris walked down from 4th ave. home in Westhaven and stayed for a brief talk, liquid refreshment and snacks.

Dave feeling a bit "low", but had dinner; took a phone call (re Trinity Alps), and watched some TV until nearly 11.

Bill drove him home because I was feeling lousy with coughs, sniffles, etc. Slept on couch.

Spent entire day ¹⁹⁷⁷ 2nd day - 363 days follow
 in ^{Epiphany} my bed on couch.

Bill fixed light meals for me. Dave came in around lunch time, watched some TV, then took set home.

Tim returned car. Rain hit hard. He & Chris did not go on bird count, but went to Patricia's Pt. to whale watch instead.

Dave brought TV back so we could watch "60-minutes" program. We watched a few shows afterwards, until nearly 11.

Bill gave Dave ride home.

Got up rather late, but dressed - and pottered around.

Arranged that Joe Tysl run projector at SC meeting at 8.

Herbert Dall phoned regarding Coastal Workshop plans.

Went to Equinox school at 6:15. No one showed up until 8. Only 6 for "Age of Alaska" movie - Wrong date had been published in Ecomews!

Bill rode home with me, after having dinner at home with Ron H. and Dave, and riding in to program with Ron.

Home by 9:30. Watched TV awhile! Still coughing, slept on couch.

up by 8. Felt like dressing 1977 4th day - 361 days follow
and doing housework. Bill went into
school for several hours.

Took Dave's chain saw to him around
3, then went on into Arcata. Brief stop
at Env. Center. Shopped for groceries for Dave
so he could barbecue chicken for
brother John and Robin when they
stopped overnight - enroute home
in B.C.

Fixed chicken in marinade, put
a tossed salad together and went
up road about 6:30. Took TV
along so we could all view new
hour long CBS show "Who's who".

John (with cold) very quiet. We
had a good evening - and it
rained, very hard at times, but
even so Bill, Robin & Dave took
a short walk.

Home around 12. Fell asleep on
couch watching Johnny Carson.

Took down Christmas lights
and decorations.

Saw little red fox $\frac{1}{2}$ mile south of
Sufferkaltz Beach as we drove to Dave's place.
He ran ahead of car in headlights.

1977 5th day - 360 days follow Rained during night. Clearing
with lovely clouds during forenoon. Up at 8.
Dave here briefly about 8:30 on way to
work at school. Bill left about 10.

Did housecleaning, washing and a lot of
ironing. Beautiful day - cool.

Dave here briefly again, around
4 - on way home - would be back
for dinner.

Went for brisk walk to Sufferkaltz
Beach around 9-9:30 in C.O.D.,
clear (full) moonlight.

Dave returned home early. He had
gotten up at 5:30 to get John and Robin
on their way, so was pretty tired.

Watched TV off and on - falling
asleep frequently. Cold much better,
but still feeling dehydrated.

Wind began coming up
after midnight.

up by 7:45. Bill left 7:15. 1977 6th day - 359 days follow

Clear, crisp, cold (frost missed us) and quite windy. Ocean beautiful! Worked around house; ironing, etc.

Stayed home all day. Dave showed up on way home from working at school. Bill got home early, but took off to get to Harbor light before 5 to pick up some lumber.

After CBS news we went up to Davis for dinner. Francis Welker popped in for a moment, about 7:30, on way to Eureka to meet with aide of Senator Cranston re Siskiyou Wilderness. She had phoned earlier from Senior Devall's. (Bill (Jr.) had returned from Bay Area with F.W.).

We watched some TV, then went for moonlight walk along Senior Drive.

Home by 10:15. In bed early - watched TV programs as long as eyes stayed open!

1977 7th day - 358 days follow

Beautiful. Clear. Cold. Ron H. showed up around 9. He + Bill had breakfast while I talked to staff at Coastal Com. offices. Then they went to work "dawn under".

I read part of new coastal act regulations, procedures, etc.

Did some wood sawing after lunch. Bill went into school briefly, leaving Ron to hammer away. Dave appeared around 3, on way home from school.

Overcast afternoon - actually warm in the sunny areas around the house.

Took things to Becky before 5.

Stopped at Davis for walk on beach at sunset. He rode home with me for dinner. Ron + Bill worked until 7:20.

Dave + I went to the Devall's at 8 for color TV of Mt. Everest climb.

Clear and cold - 28°F . ¹⁹⁷⁷ 8th day - 357 days follow

Much frost on Scenic Drive. Up at 6:40. Took some food to Davis about 7. Had breakfast there, then he left for a meeting on Trinity Alps with group of people in Weaverville.

Spent some time with Holly Gibson at Quarry site, where water monitoring was in progress. We talked to man doing the checking. Surface water 12' in one spot; down to 5-6' in another.

Ron worked with Bill all day long.

Dave returned in time for dinner, but had already eaten. Ron & Bill ate by themselves, as I was not very hungry.

Ron went up to Dave's.

¹⁹⁷⁷ 9th day - 356 days follow

Up at 8:15. Lovely day. Breezy here, but heavy frost up on Scenic Drive.

Dave phoned about walking. Left at 11:30 - met him (and MT) above Suffer-Lolly Beach, north; walked briskly - with-out sweater - got ^{back} to house at 12:30. Starting time for "Super Bowl XL" on TV. Ron took them out from work on new room "down under" to watch game, also. Dave made a lot of popcorn for all of us.

Went to McK for pizza, after a walk to Sufferholty just before dark.

Watched a TV special from 8-10. "That's Entertainment", a review of MGM musicals, stars, etc. over 50 years.

Ron went to Dave's place for the night, giving Dave a ride home.

Rain began.

Showers. Much warmer today. 1977 10th day - 355 days follow

Went to Arcata + Eureka from 10:30 - 3:30. Shopping at the mall, down town, doing errands. Made a (new recipe) meat loaf for dinner.

Dave arrived about 6:30.

Later I drove up to his place, about 9:45 to listen to a couple of records.

Home by 11:30.

Bill and Dave on phone to Jan Knapp at Davis - re algae, etc.

Had lunch with Eve Davis at The Mall after meeting by chance. Regional Coastal Commission met tonight in Eureka, but I didn't feel like attending.

1977 11th day - 354 days follow

up by 7. Bill gone by 7:30. Heavy rain at times.

Worked around house. Taped up letters to Ventana Chapter re Coastal Coordinators support by Redwood Chapter.

Went to Arcata on errands. Did some Xeroxing, stopped at Env. Center; shopped for groceries in M.K. Very heavy downpour between 3 and 4.

Dave here for dinner - about 8. Both Bill and Dave put in long day at school.

Watched TV until bedtime - about 12:45. Dave went home around 9:30 - tired!

Up at 7. Storm 1977 12th day - 353 days follow
clearing - lovely snowing. Bill
got away around 10.

Worked around house.
Wrote thank you note to Dennis
Jones (at Lakeside, VT).

1977 13th day - 352 days follow watched early TV news
while still in bed! Breakfast after 8. Bill
away by 7:30.

Fair, but rather cool. Did some
washing. Took things to Becky
after lunch.

Dave came by around 5 -
just after I had returned from
Arata - to clean up his camper.

Tim McKay and John Corbett
came in around 5:30. John had just
flown in from SF, where he attended
State Coastal Commission meeting -
when regional com's. were re-activated.

Tim took Falcon to me over weekend.

Dave went home after a very
short walk after dinner.

Ed Wayburn phoned about RNP
task force. Hamilton News phoned
to see about ride to MCCC in Davis.

up at 5:10. Dave late - 6:10. ¹⁹⁷⁷ 14th day - 351 days follow

Breakfast in (37°F) Laytonville. Much frost and some icy spots on highway. Overtook BLM station wagon near Hualdsburg, switched cars, leaving Dave to go into SF alone - to have lunch with Ed W. and others talking Redwoods.

Bob Saunders & wife, Mel Clausen & wife, John Tarter and I met at Rudy Platzer's office in Sausalito, then walked to nice place near water for lunch. Held our "meeting" over lunch.

John T. and I took 3:15 ferry boat to S.F. Very windy and cold. Walked to Sierra Club offices by 4:30. Found Dave there. Talked to Paul Swatoff, saw Franica Walker.

Met Ken Collins at Ken's restaurant in Chinatown. Had wonderful dinner, then walked (by 8:30) to Opera House for SF Symphony and Janet Baker, contralto. Dave and I sat together - last row in balcony. Great performance.

Ken took us to "pub", then drove us to Dave's car parked way out at Steiner & Pine. We followed Ken across Bay Bridge and stopped at Valley's.

up at 7:30. Cold, foggy. Breakfast at The Nut Tree on way to Davis. Dave phoned Bill & Jon &

NCRCC meeting 9:30-5 at Memorial Union Bldg. About 60 people attending.

We ducked out for hamburgers at lunch break. Dave and I were voting delegates. Tried to reach Jan Krupp, but without luck, so headed toward 101 via highway 12 through Sonoma.

Excellent dinner at La Casa, across from Sonoma Mission Inn.

Fell asleep en route, awakened by stop along Russian River.

Dave stopped driving around 1/145.

[Meeting was "buzzy" and even "emotional" over boycott/whales policy. Tony took there - got news of tree planting dates for Feb.]

On way by 8. Some 1977 16th day - 349 days follow
 fog in valleys. Breakfast near
 Ukiah. In Eureka by 12:30.
 Stopped at The Mall, had
 lunch at Deb's and got home
 by 2 - Sun was out -

Changed clothes, went up road
 with Dave, who also changed so
 we could walk back to Moonstone.
 After a highball we walked back
 to Dave's place. Bill came out
 up later and we had dinner there
 and watched 60 minutes when
 Bill brought TV set up by car.
 Home again before 10.
 Clear; starry bright.

1977 17th day - 348 days follow 37°F 8 AM. Variable

 Dave dropped by on way to school.
 Talked to David Personon regarding
 coastal access lawsuit - Zanone -
 Petrolia.

Went with Dave to his place at 5:30,
 left car, got MT and walked briskly
 back home by 6:20. Bill met us near
 Luffenbally by prearrangement.

Took Dave home around 9:45 -
 stayed for one record.

Clear; cold again and starry bright.

37° at 8 am

Awakened with phone call 1977 18th day - 347 days follow
from Brock Evans in SL offices, Wash., D.C.
re. land near Yolla Bolly wilderness.

Worked around house until 11.

On phone a lot re. Exlom., etc.
Lovely, with scattered high clouds.

1977

19th day - 346 days follow

Up at 6:10. Left 6:30 to drive
to Samoa Creekhouse on Samoa Peninsula. 7 AM
Sunrise's (Eureka) Lions Club breakfast-
Guest speaker, talking briefly (about
 $\frac{1}{2}$ hr.) about Sierra Club & local issues.

Did house cleaning, etc. after returning
home promptly - about 8:30.

Had ^{SLC} Exlom meeting at Van Kirk's
home from 3-5. (New member "Bud" Clarke
did not show up.) Conrad Bonifazi, Pat Ferris,
Suise Van Kirk, Bill Sevall, Kave Van de Mark
all there.

Took wash before dinner,
Dave Lee.

Clear + cool. Went to 1977 20th day - 345 days follow
 HSV by 9. Gave Sierra Club talk to
 Pol. Science I class (C. Johnson) following
 a Straight Arrow Coalition (SAC) speaker.
 Went to Env. Center to turn in Econews
 material.

Worked around Lance.

Went for walk with Dave + MT
 before dinner.

Took Dave home around 9:30.

1977 21st day - 344 days follow Variable Cloudiness.

Started some washing.

Hal Wickman phoned from Arcata.
 We planned fresh crab dinner.
 Took things to Becky around 5.
 Went up to Daves, with him, at 5:30.
 We grabbed some wood from beach, then
 walked briskly to Moonstone. Ron and Bill
 were working "down under" until time
 to eat. Dave and Ron joined us
 (Hal and friend Rick).

We stayed up until 12. Took
 Dave home. Ron stayed here
 over night - in dining room, while
 I used couch.

Cleaned up kitchen before 1977 22nd day - 343 days follow
Don Turtle arrived around 10 to look at
old, rare Humboldt book. Bill and Ron
had late breakfast (about 10:30).

Dave phoned, needed help typing materials
for Ecosw. I went up there around 11.
Finished before 1. Pat Ferris showed up
at 1 to work on maps. I took & typed
pages to Env. Center, edited further with
Mike Altkruss. Jerry Kelger there. We
discussed water quality board changes.
Andy Turtle and Chris Souza now appointed
to serve!

Did some grocery shopping, then
home to finish laundry work. Too
late to take a walk.

Fixed dinner up at Dave's place
for John Amadio's planned evening
get together. Made tuna quiche &
Ron and Bill joined us.

Took walk after dinner south on
Senie Drive about $3\frac{1}{4}$ mile. Starry bright
and cool. Ron had to drive me home
because John had inadvertently pocketed
Falcon keys! Bill went home earlier,
riding with John. In bed by 12:15.

1977 23rd day - 342 days follow Clear (mostly) and cool.
Up before 7. Walked Senie Drive. Met Dave and
MT near Baker's Beach at 7:30. Returned to his
place, then Ron joined us for pancake waffles at
The Eatery. At 9:30 I headed home after
talking to Sue Morris on phone after Dave had
made plans with Bob for meeting re Trinity Alps.
Worked around house, did some sewing,
enjoying sun in bedroom.

Walked up Senie Drive (5:30) with
Bill, who went only to McGlynn's, but I
went on, meeting Dave & Ron north of
Lupfenbally.

Watched 60 minutes, then heated up
some chicken pies for dinner - and then
watched 2 hr. TV show "Roots" - the
story by (once) slave family Alex Haley.
Excellent film - good acting - to be
continued in long week series.

Took Dave & Ron home by 11:30.

Had long phone talk with Herna Guthrie.

Sunny, then foggy, 1977 24th day - 341 days follow
then variable cloudiness.

Worked around house, cleaning
oven, defrosting refrigerator, clipping
newspapers, etc. Even started some
laundry for Dave.

Brief sojourn, quick errands in
Acreta 2:30-3:30.

Watched "Roots" (for 1 hr.)

1977 25th day - 340 days follow

Up early - Clear, cool,
lovely. Picked up Steve Brewer in Trinidad at
8:15, then ~~John Amadio in Acreta at 8:35~~. Went to
Coast District Technical Advisory Board (TAC)
meeting at Ag. Bldg. (at Spruce Point).

Heavy discussion of accumulative effect of
THPs in a single watershed or basin.
Many timber types, forests, etc. there.

Lunch at Sea Food Gratts with Reg Frankel
and (Dr.) Phil Flint, both on Committee, and
the new chairman Harry Camp and Pete
Panof, also on board, and vice-chair.

Meeting lasted until 4 p.m. Steve
stayed in Eureka to go to CDF office.
Home by 5.

Went for walk to Sufferhally with
Bill at 5:30. Lovely sunset.

Watched "Roots" from 10-11.

Dave off to Weaverville - overnight
- at Collins, after meeting with Bob
Morris and others.

Clear, cool, then warming. 1977 26th day - 339 days follow

Worked around home - putting place in order somewhat - before Sally Cornell from the Union arrived to interview me for a feature her editor had "hooked up" - about environmentalists in Humboldt County. Sally here 1:30 - 3:30.

Picked up Steve Brewer again at 3:40, then John Amadio and we all attended a workshop put on by No. Coast Water Quality Control Board at City Hall Council Chambers, 4-6. New Board members Andrea Tuttle and Chris Souza and (Dr.) Stephen Warwick on hand.

Left Steve & John in town for dinner. Home by 6:50. Dave came in, grabbed dinner, said home by 7:30, expecting people to show up to work on Trinity Alps boundaries. Bill D. here briefly to leave SC material.

At 9:15 or so I drove up to get Dave, so he could watch "Roots" from 10-11.

He drove my car back.

1977 27th day - 338 days follow up at 6:30. Ate quickly and left by 7 to meet Dave & MT and pick up my car around Baker's beach. Just getting light at 7. Some frost "around the edges".

Home again 7:30. Quick bath, then at 8:40 scooped up John Amadio on Upper Bay Rd. in Arcata. Went to Eureka City Hall for regular meeting of N.C.W.Q.C.B. 9-1.

Excellent meeting with new board members giving staff good support.

Discussion of streamside protection, monitoring, etc. Also "DOS" phase II, and Technical Advisory (Policy) Committee. Structure and representations came under heavy discussion.

Lunch, alone, at Stattons, then ~~right home~~ a brief stop at Regional Coastal Comm. offices. Home by 5, after picking up John (from CDF offices). Dave came in. Went with him to get wood from beach - just getting dark, then returned home by 6:30 newswire.

Dave stayed on after dinner to see "Roots" at 10-11. Made some phone calls to ExLom members in Ukiah & Santa Rosa.

Clear, cool. Up by 7:30. 1977 28th day - 337 days follow

Went up to Dave's place by 10:30. Helped him on Trinity Alps map work for tomorrow's meeting in Santa Rosa.

Picked up hamburgers from The Eatery around 1. Greg Bidmonstrom showed up with more information from Klamath National Forest offices.

Took things to Becky.

Home around 4. Went to Arcata before 5 to do some taping and borrow a projector from Ralph Haldinger.

Bob Morris arrived rather late - he stayed overnight with Dave so we could get early morning start for Santa Rosa.

1977

29th day - 336 days follow

Alarm & phone 4:20 A.M. Picked up Bob Rain in Arcata at 5. Clear here, foggy all the way down to Santa Rosa. Met at ~~conference~~ community use room in Coddington. (Bob Morris did all the driving. Breakfast in Garberville about 7.)

Ken Collins showed up - from SE - for part of meeting. Not as many people on hand as desired, but the Trinity Alps scenic boundary proposal went over pretty well. The meeting ended before 3.

We had a "quick one" for the road - Al Whitney joined us.

Bob did all driving home. Places in Garberville closed at nine ~~had~~ so we tried to get there on time.

Left Bob Rain at his home in Arcata. Bob Morris stayed overnight at Dave's.

Up by 7:30. Walked to Dave's place by 9. Bill, Bob, Dave & I then walked over to The Eatery for banana waffle breakfast. Variable cloudiness - no real need for jacket.

Worked around house until Dave called about wood hunting, and after several calls he made up his mind where to go -

Went wood collecting west of Willow Creek. Rain began about 6:30. Bill met us in McK. for pizza around 7:15. Last (2 hrs.) episode of "Roots" 9-11 PM on TV.

Dave stayed here.

1977 31st day - 334 days follow Awoke with sore throat, Social Security and Withholding Tax Return Due lingered in bed.

Walked to Dave's place to get Falcon, but it won't start. Fiddled around, but Dave worried about materials for Bill's 11 o'clock lab, so we hitchhiked down to Moonstone so he could quickly leave for school in his car. Arrived 2. He returned. Bought new spark plugs, which he installed for me. Home again around 4:45. Dave attended ~~Letchford~~ Emerald Creek committee meeting - leaving MT with us.

Felt weary - so ate lightly and went to bed (couch) early. Dave retrieved MT around 11:30.

Quick walk to beach near Dave's place to pick up wood.

up at 6. Clear (foggy in places) and cold. 31° in Eureka. 1977 32nd day - 333 days follow

Left 7:15 for 8 o'clock Nat'l. Resources class at College of the Redwoods. Talked about Sierra Club (showed slides) until 9:30. Stopped at Env. Center briefly. Home by 11:30. Started laundry work.

Dave phone 12:45. Arranged lunch at Eatery; then photos along scenic drive - follow up for County records regarding undergrounding of utilities. Left Tolson to be culled, etc. in Trinidad.

Beautiful, warm afternoon. Finished photos (2 to 3 p.m.) in 1 mile stretch, Moonstone cul-de-sac to Lippenshoty Creek.

Retrieved car about 6 - Bill gave me ride. Went to Eureka by 8:45 to mail letter special delivery re. T.A. Then enjoyed dinner at Shanghai Town.

Found one of our Rhododendrons flowering!

1977 33rd day - 332 days follow Cool, clear, beautiful. Two beautiful up by 7:45.

Worked around home. Took care of some conservation business, by phone.

Went for bicycle ride, after lunch, to Baker's beach. Absolutely glorious afternoon.

Worked on material for Redwood needles and then went to Dave's before 5 - but missed mailing time - both of us!

Went to beach before 6. Picked up drift wood for fireplace.

Dave came down for dinner around 7. We watched President Carter's first TV report to the people.

Dave went home by 9:30 after taking a moonlight walk with Bill and M.T.

I didn't feel good. Cold? Went to bed early and watched some TV.

Having sink problems - not draining - called Scott Long.

Variable cloudiness.

1977

34th day - 331 days follow

Two young men arrived around 10 and worked two hard hours trying to unclog sink drain - and were successful.

Foot Grabbed Sorted color slides for use at COR evening Nat'l. Res. class. Grabbed sandwich and coffee in Arcata on way to 7 o'clock class.

Had 3 full hours talking Sierra Club, conservation issues, etc.

Coffee + pie at Stanton's on way home. Beautiful, clear.

Talked briefly with Barbara Richter near Stanton's.

Expected Gordon Robinson to come by, but he never showed up.

Dave came in at 11:30 to pick up MT, after he had dinner, etc. in Arcata at Lunch's.

1977

35th day - 330 days follow

Lucky day - Warm.
Bill had 9 am dental appt.

Took things to Becky around 11, then drove to Eureka to meet Gordon Robinson at Court House and have lunch in town. Found him in Timber Dept. Assessor's office. Joined by helpers Mike Matthews and Bob Rhode. Picked up key from Chamber of Commerce (for tomorrow's workshop).

~~Home again by 5~~

Ron and Bill put in some insulation "down under".

Made "Goop" for Bill + Ron to take to CNPS patluck in Arcata at 6:30.

Gordon, Bob, Steve Bremer, Steve Lan, John A. Randy Stemler, Dave and I had fresh eel, salad, french bread, beer + wine for dinner.

Bruce Kennedy arrived from Sacramento about 10. With others departing, Dave, Gordon, Bruce, and I were joined by Bill and Ron ^{and Bob Horton} on moonlight walk to Luffenbally. Gordon went home with Dave; Bruce stayed at Obourstone; also Ron + Bob Horton - all in sleeping bag.

up by 7:15. Went to airport 1977 36th day - 329 days follow
by 8 to meet Celis and Norbert Doss. In 2
cars, we met at Red Lion coffee shop in Eureka
for breakfast. At 8:15 we opened Chamber of
Commerce Bldg., where Coastal Workshop would
take place in conference room. It began to
rain! Only 2 people showed - Warner
Chabot from Mendocino and Dick Lauen
from Eureka (Regional Conct. staff).

We broke for lunch at 1 - and went on
working - going over maps in regard to
special treatment areas as pertains to
logging in Coastal zone. At 4:30 we left.
Did quick errand for Dave, then straight to
airport by 5. Rain light and sketchy.

Bruce & I went up to Dave's place after
saying our goodbyes at airport. John Amadio
there going over redwood photos. Before

Sunbathed on deck, carefully screened from "bared" neighbor Markwell.

Went to Arcata to Xerox and into Eureka, to mail, F.S. letter.

Bill Devall came by after dinner.

¹⁹⁷⁷ 181st day - 184 days follow

Overcast. Did some laundry work (started it) then at 11 went up road to View Crest Hotel Lodge to talk "proposed project" with Peggy Conway. She sent me home full of freshly juiced carrots, celery, apples, parsley, etc.

Stopped in Trinidad with Tom Pratte and neighbors, talking over proposed bluff top residences above Tsurui Village. Home by 2.

Dave returned with full load of firewood, which went to Senior Devalls.

Spent considerable time shopping and loading car to go to Patricia's by 2. Talked to Dave very briefly - he would come up for quick dinner.

A few people had already pitched tents at Bench Creek Group Campground.

I fixed up an array of wine, juices, cheese spreads and crackers. Others continued to come in during late afternoon.

A happy time prevailed. Visitors delighted with lovely park and the area in general.

Dave came out for quick salad and hot dogs, then right back to dark room renovations.

Al Whitney gave me a ride home to feed cat and check house for the night.

Put sleeping bag near tree edged open space. Rubbed by 11.

About 6 tents scattered around.

1977 191st day - 174 days follow

Beautiful day after fog cleared. Exec. Com. meeting began at 9:30. Susie came out. Bill D. showed up for lunch. Dave stayed only until 12:30. Meeting ended around 1.

Sunbathed. Rested awhile lying on pad in meadow.

and left again about 9.

Dave made tacos for himself.

1977 195th day - 170 days follow Foggy until noon.

Charlie Bower arrived to help lay
new carpet in research room -
We tugged, pulled, cut, trimmed, etc.
One quick trip into Builders Supply in
Mck. to get some materials.

We were still working at 5:30, but
Charlie had to leave. He borrowed Dave's
chainsaw for a small chase at Big
Lagoon for a friend.

Dave, having spent most of day in
Acreton, phoned late. We went to

burger.

1977 196th day - 169 days follow

Foggy until noon.

Phone call from Jim Rose from Eureka at 7:30. Working, unloading frozen food truck from Modesto and Sacramento, I met him at the terminal. We sat in car talking about one Laine. He looked thin, had short hair, very wiry, very pleasant, but steeped in his religious beliefs, as his letters have reflected over the past few years.

Located photo from County files that showed old bluff line road near Trinidad, and it appeared to duck down into Parker Creek gulch. Ordered 2 copies, 8x10. Went to NEC awhile.

Sam bathed awhile, then took groceries to Becky. Did some pruning in garden.

Dave shaved hot dogs and zucchini and sliced peaches with me.

Took short walk.

Picked up paint at Humboldt Paint Factory and saying goodbye to Jim.

1977 197th day - 168 days follow

Foggy until after lunch. About 57°F. Discovered water on floor of shower room. Managed to get a plumber out from Bayide. Toilet was re-seated and a bad valve replaced.

Did a couple of machine loads of washing. Steve Law phoned re RNP.

Food cat food to Becky around 1:30. Saw Dave very briefly as he was leaving house for lunch. Sunbathed 3-4.

Painted and stained and sanded door, table top and table frames.

Dave came down for W Wenis and made some tacos for himself. I ate eggs and toast.

Very warm - approx. 95°F and very smoky. Some had sandwiches from The Deli at Coffee Creek, others beer and/or water. Dave marked a map to leave for Dick Thorpe, who had planned to join us Friday night, if possible.

Left Dave's pick up at Little Trinity River trail head - then all stuffed in van went on to High Camp Creek.

Located trail of sorts. Van left where Dick could find it, hopefully. Went on to lovely meadow with adequate, but not plentiful supply of water in very tiny stream. Lovely big cedars in mixed conifer stand.

Beautiful starry night. Had no dinner, but others did. Everyone ready to bed down fairly early.

231st day - 134 days follow
1977 Lovely morning. Good breakfast, then underway shortly after 9. Made our way on trail to junction, where note was left for Dick. Dave took off around South China Mtn. in search of lake basin for camp. Very warm. Julie & Deborah wearing shorts. I was slow. We went up - and, over - 8542' China Mtn. Dropping into West Park Lakes basin was over huge rock slide. At the end of a long, hot day, we were all picking our way down to the lake extremely cautiously.
