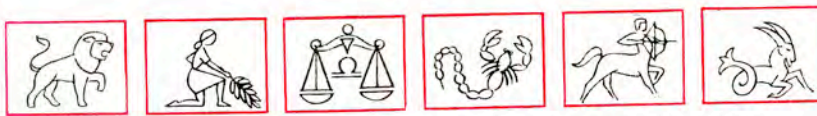

JANUARY

1978 1st day - 364 days follow
New Year's Day

Phone call 8:15 from Dave to go walking. Cloudy. Met him at Luffenholtz, returned home for breakfast.

At 10:20 left on walk to catch 11 o'clock football game on TV at his place. (Denver vs. Dallas)

At half time drove Dave's car home so I could clean up kitchen & eat lunch.

Watched 2nd half in kitchen.

Went back to Dave's place to watch the rest game (Vikings vs. Cowboys), which didn't end until dark. Phoned Bill to try to meet us near Luffenholtz. We walked briskly with some light sprinkles at times.

as we watched "60 minutes" as we ate dinner. Dave napped while Bill & I watched Carol Burnett show.

Took Dave home before 10.

Rain during night. 1978 2nd day - 363 days follow

Up at 8:30. Watched Rose Parade on TV.

Walked to Lupperholty around 12:30. Bill went part way, then went onto school for a staff meeting. Dave phoned between Sugar Bowl and Rose Bowl games about walking (maybe) later.

Watched 2 other games before day was over - some of it up at Dave's place.

1978 3rd day - 362 days follow Variable cloudiness and light showers.

Robert Dale phoned. Coming up tomorrow.

Walked to Lupperholty Creek.

Went to Dr. Frank at 1:30. X-ray of head, many of them, taken.

Spent remainder of afternoon and evening lying low. Head kind of "burning".

Charlie Bower, Scott Kline, Eric Watson and Ron Huntsinger were here during evening. (Dave had gone to dinner with a woman named Collins.)

Tom Pratte called after midnight about the Trinidad City Council meeting.

JANUARY

4

WEDNESDAY

Rain.

Cloudy, windy and ¹⁹⁷⁸ raining — but in mid 50's. 4th day — 361 days follow

Helped Dave by typing up community on South Fork Mtn. Planning Unit — from 11-1:30 — Head feeling better.

Took Dave to airport (3:30) and swapped up Norbert.

Fed Norbert at home so he could spend some time going over Trinidad General Plan and Recommended conditions.

At 5:45 I got M.T., then picked up Tom Pratte. Rain continuing.

Attended Coastal Com. meeting at 7-9:45 at Caltrans Bldg. Norbert spoke for Sierra Club. Quite a number of Trinidad residents on hand; only a few made comments.

Cocktails at Eureka Inn later; pizza at midnight.

Heavy wind, rain, lightning. Home by 12:10. Power had been off awhile.

Put Norbert on living room couch.

THURSDAY

5

JANUARY

1978 5th day — 360 days follow

Rain showers. Stevie Delle phone call at 7:15 got us up. A quick breakfast, then at 8:30 picked up Tom in Trinidad.

Meeting at Caltrans Bldg. again, starting at 9. Norbert spoke on a couple of issues and I spoke twice on permits. Lunch in upstairs cafeteria 12-1.

Took Norbert to airport by 3:30. Relaxed at home remainder of evening. Had phone calls from Earl Blauner (SC Legal Defense Fund) and late evening call from Tom, who had returned to Arcata with Bill Devall (who had joined us at lunch).

Bill took MT for short walk between showers after dinner.

Talked to David and Gerry (phone).

JANUARY

6

FRIDAY

1.3" rain.

Rain stopped by 7:30.

1978

6th day - 359 days follow

Variable cloudiness throughout day.

Worked around the house and then shipped newspapers.

Picked up Dave at airport around 3:30. He would head out for meeting in Trinity County, following phone call (earlier) from Bot Morris. I had terse words for him regarding NT's neglected condition.

Went up to Tim McKay's after dinner to get SC ballots counted. Home again by 9.

1978

7th day - 358 days follow

Did a lot of laundry work.

Biel went to an all day session on Remote Sensing.

SUNDAY

Worked around the ¹⁹⁷⁸ 8th day - 357 days follow

Epiphany

most of day after spending some time at Moonstone Beach. The 8.1' tide was battering the parking area bank, eating it away rapidly. Very exciting to watch the force of the surges push and toss huge logs around. Many observers, including Sam (Bud) Merlyman and young daughter - we were taking photos - joined by Bill with movie camera. Nice day - quite warm at times.

Tim & Chris came down to help finish count of 56 ballots before time for "60 minutes."

JANUARY

¹⁹⁷⁸ 9th day - 356 days follow up at 6:30. Clear here, but densely foggy in Everett. Arrived at Regional Coastal Com. office at 7:30 and began taping session again. Had to go out to purchase additional tape as the taping being copied were very lengthy.

Went with Dick Larsen to view tidal action at King Salmon - at high tide. Had a hamburger & coffee at Pati's Cafe, joined by an acquaintance of Dick's.

Did some errands. Picked up 2 silver spoons (ordered on birthday).

Stopped at Van Kirk's. Waited for Lucie to return - meanwhile, tried to get little Joe to learn about piano.

Found Ron H. & friend Welton Kirk had been digging out another section under the house to put more flooding in.

Picked up Tom Pratte at 7. We began review of Trinidad plan. Bill Devall came in awhile. Tom had dinner with us, which Bill prepared.

Watched part of a TV movie showing then took Tom home - about 1:00 a.m.

Some went to Yuba for RARE II ^{evening} meeting.

JANUARY

10

Wednesday
TUESDAY

Scattered showers. 1978 10th day - 355 days follow

Bill off to school around 10. Made several phone calls re Sierra Club, then cleaned up kitchen.

Walked down to beach to see continuing eating away of parking area and collection of drift - getting very close to the 3 parked trailer houses and beach house.

Did some letter writing (Sierra Club) and mailed things around 4:30 in Trinidad. Gave check to Vivian Burnett for T-shirts.

Bill stayed in town for dinner due to early special class at 6 -
-- Remote Sensing --

Tom Pratte phoned late after attending Citizens + Council meeting in Trinidad. They were working with circuit riding Planner on word changing in the General Plan.

Monday
WEDNESDAY

11

JANUARY

1978 11th day - 354 days follow

Cloudy. Dave popped in on way to school. I would not talk much to him because of lack of consideration for MT's skin problems.

Went to Eureka by 1. Took Ecuadorian hanging (women) (from Greg Kroll) to Mary Livingston to leave for repair of frayed edges.

Went to Vision Center about glasses, then by 3 to Regional Coastal Com. offices.

Began taping public hearing sessions on conditions for Irish Beach proposal. Took sometime to get set up. Worked until 5.

Dave did not come down for dinner because he was "tied up" - entertaining at home, and not going to S.C. meeting.

Went to Sierra Club + (Friends of Earth) meeting at Arcata Community Park at 7:30. Al Stuen showed slides of Yupon River trip, June-July 1977, taken with Bob Plank.

Home by 10:30.

0.2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rain (yesterday + overnight) 1978 12th day - 353 days follow

Bill away by 10. Light rain.

Tacked to Gerry (brother) awhile in pursuing whereabouts of Gerry (niece). Had phone calls regarding possible coastal appeals - and one call from a Commissioner regarding a future proposal at Crescent City.

Went to Eureka around 3 - Light rain at times. Bought a camera case to send to Nancy Dagle (Sierra Club). Looked over aerial photos and slides at County Resources office. Home by dark.

Dave showed up, but stayed only briefly.

Tom Phatte phoned after dinner to say he had listened to tape of remainder of last night's meeting in Trinidad.

Watched "Scenes from a Marriage" (Liv Ullmann) on PBS, then some later programs.

Long talk with Dennis Jones, from Bigfork, MT, re. environmental involvement.

1978 13th day - 352 days follow

It rained a lot during night. Wind gusty morning hours. Variable cloudiness - Phone call from Mark Davis (EDA, Wash.) that Woolley Island ^{main} project will probably proceed.

Took things to Becky around 1:45. Saw Dave near post office and planned going together to Van Kirs.

Dave Schneider, agent and engineer (LACO) picked me up in Trinidad at 2 pm. We drove to Crescent City to look over a land division proposal which S.C. indicated it would appeal decision to State, granted by regional commission last week. In the Jordan Creek drainage we got wet feet and wet heads from continuing light showers. Later, ^{at} harbor facilities briefly, a heavy squall hit at same time tsunami alert sirens blasted overhead. It was a false alarm, but still spine tingling - all that wailing.

Van Kirs entertained North Group Ex. Com. Conrad Bonifazi, Bill D., Dave, Nancy Reichert, guest John Amadio. We elected new chairman (Susie). I would serve as vice chairman.

Dave & I took John A. home around 10.

up early. Picked up Dave, 1978 14th day - 351 days follow
left at 7. Breakfast at Red Lion Inn,
Eureka. Left Eureka about 8:10. Much
rain all the way to Ukiah. Stopped briefly
at Smith Redwood Preserve to view vandalism
of cut giant redwoods.

ExCom meeting at Savings & Loan in
Ukiah from 11:15 to 4:15. Named
chairman for another year. David Maxon
of Ukiah named vice chairman.

We had heavy discussion on peripheral
canal issue.

Dave covered public lands issues
and current "negotiations" regarding
timberlands taking place with various
interests, including forest service.

I drove part way home - sometimes in
torrential downpours. Some slides, rivers
rising, etc. Had a cocktail and light
dinner at Stanton's in Eureka at 8:30.

Found Bill gone, but Greg at
Dave's place for the night. Bill
phoned later from Lris.

Home by 11:30. Stars out!

~nearly 2" rain

1978 15th day - 350 days follow Heavy wind and rain
Martin Luther King's Birthday during night

Walked down to beach after breakfast.
Parking area banks still eroding away
with the heavy surf and battering rains
of large drift logs.

Dave came in briefly around noon.
Around 2:30 I took small TV set
and joined him to watch Super
Bowl 12 (from New Orleans). Dallas
vs Denver, 27-10. Good game.

Back home for dinner & "60 minutes".
Dave came down in his own car.

He took a phone call from a
CR resources student which turned out
to be quite lengthy (re. forest practices).

RCx not feeling well today - Will
get her into vet. soon. Rain &
wind continued throughout evening.
Ready for bed around midnight.

JANUARY

16

MONDAY

2.4" rain

Clearing after day light. 1978 16th day - 349 days follow

Dave + I + MT walked briskly to Luffenholty Beach between 9-9:30. Warm.

Took P.C. to vets at 11:10. She had antibiotic for an abscess and got a worm pill also.

Went to Eureka after lunch. Had eye examination and found little change over 5 years. Picked out new frames.

Went to Coastal Com. offices. Waiting for one of the permit analysts, I joined some of the staff for 3 o'clock coffee. Home by dark. Raining hard.

Phoned Norbert, just home from Washington, D.C. BOD meeting. Worked on coastal appeal.

TUESDAY

17

JANUARY

.8" rain

1978 17th day - 348 days follow

Phone call from Tom Prutter got me up at 7:45. Took quick walk to Baker's Beach. Dave brought me home. Norbert phoned 11 o'clock.

Worked on appeal - ready to type by 2 - finished by 4.

Xeroxed in Anata; mailed appeal.

At 6:30 we joined others for tacos at Dave's place - John Amodio, Steve Law, Ray + Chloé Peart, Brent Twoomey.

At 8:30 left for Trinidad City Hall for meeting/discussion among concerned citizens, City Council members, Coastal staff people and 3 regional commissioners re. Trinidad General Plan.

Home by 10:15. Cloudy.

P.C. much happier cat today.

Up by 7:30. Made a quick 1978 18th day - 347 days follow
sound trip to Trinidad looking things over.

Did some S.C. letter writing and raced into Eureka post office before 10:30. Stopped at Susie's on way home; also brief stop at NEC.

Back at Moonstone just before noon and just minutes ahead of Greg Keall.

Greg left his car with me for a couple of days while he ^{would be} ~~was~~ in Monterey.

Bill staying in town to attend evening class.

Vivian Burnett came down to pick up check for tie shirts. Together we looked at the McCollum house - new renters in already.

Ron + Weston Kirk left some building materials here.

Spent quiet evening - reading and TV watching at times.

Bill home by 10.

1978 19th day - 346 days follow

a late breakfast - no rush today. Heavy rains at times. The spit was again all washed over.

Worked on S.C. material for Ecomers. Rained at times.

Did laundry in Arcata 2:30 - 3:00. Stopped at NEC - went to County Planning Dept in Eureka - quick trip.

Did clothes drying at home.

Had late night phone call from Nick Argimban re Peripheral Canal and the SC's stand.

Had good talk with Zorbet Dall. Also phoned Ellen Christensen re. Coastal position fund appeal.

FRIDAY

1.6" rain

Up early. Sunshine and clouds! Another long distance call re Canal issues.

Dave phoned around 9:30 - working on Hog fire (FS) letters.

Took things to Becky around 4:30, then brief stop at Dave's place to see what plans for trip to NCRCC meeting would be.

Late phone calls to NCRCC people - we would NOT be at meeting Saturday.

SATURDAY

21

JANUARY

showers

1978

21st day - 344 days follow

Went up to Dave's place around 9. We worked all day on (his) writing and (my) typing of D.C. reports for NCRCC meeting in Davis tomorrow; for E@NEWS and Redwood Needles.

Rushed things into Arcata to be copied - ready for mailing, etc.

Took short walk on beach before dark.

Had dinner at home. Bill, Ron, and friend Welton working "down under". Dave + I got away around 9 PM. Much fog. Stopped in Willits.

Left Falcon at Dave's place.

Low fog, cold, then ^{Septuagesima Sunday} very clear and windy. Breakfast in Clear Lake Lake. Reached Davis by 10:30. Meeting just starting. Short break for lunch (we grabbed hamburgers nearby).

Report on wilderness issues, RARE II, ski developments, etc. were well covered. David presented maps and slides of the Hog fire salvage logging area - proposed by Klamath Forest.

Had cocktails at Voyages Inn, then went to Jim Eaton's home for dinner. Bob + Ann Schneider there. Drove to Sacramento to get closer to Capitol. Clear + cold.

1978 23rd day - 342 days follow up by 7:15. Brisk and clear. In Senator Behr's office by 9. Dave joined the "river group" also. Peter spent about $\frac{1}{2}$ hour with us --- Nick Argimbeau, Tom Hudson, Mark Dubois, Richard Wilson. We presented a firm front against the peripheral canal. (Peter swing vote on conference committee). Rich Wilson was main spokesman for us. Coffee talk later, then Dave and I headed for S.C. offices. Got some additional typing done. Talked to John Zierold, Larry Moss and Norbert Dall.

Lunch at small Mexican food place near Capitol (Emma's), then we headed out for home about 2:30. Very strong wind in valley. Snow capped mountains lovely in distance. Hills green - really looks nice. Hwy. 20 to 101 from Williams. Found some cut chunks of firewood.

Ate Chinese dinner things at home around 9, picked up as we went through Eureka.

Had to retrieve Falcon when I Dave + KTT went home.

Cool, frosty. Up early. ¹⁹⁷⁸ 24th day - 341 days follow

Lots of phone calls to take care of - one regarding reintroduction of Tule Elk into Lake Pillsbury area.

→ Went to Board of Supervisors meeting 9 AM, Eureka. RV park at Big Lagoon was denied. Stopped briefly at Dave's.

Did a lot of ironing, then went for short walk on Scenic Drive. Met Dave + Tom Pratte at Luffenbath. We returned to Dave's car at Baker Beach, then was given ride home. Tom was taking photos of the "post-card" scenes along the ocean.

Bill and I had dinner around 7:30. Watched Kraft Music Hall special with Bob Hope + others from 9:30-11.

¹⁹⁷⁸ 25th day - 340 days follow Up early - left note for

Dave at 7:30 (his place) - Went to Eureka by 9. Picked up Ecuadorian wall hanging repaired by Mary Livingston. Cool, some variable cloudiness, some afternoon sun. Did some shopping and stopped at NEC. Home by 11:15.

Tom Siemery from SF Economics Research Associates (ERA) arrived about 1:30 to do interview regarding proposed ^{Community} Conference Center in Eureka Area. We talked over our home.

Had good phone talk with Joe Warner, back refreshed from 3 weeks on Costa Rica trip.

Went to Water Quality 1978 26th day - 339 days follow meeting by 10. Lunch with Eve Davis at Eureka Inn around 12:45. Got my new glasses at noon at The Vision Center.

The L-P, BLM, Wilson, etc. logging roads as viewed by WQ was a lengthy public hearing; also spraying of herbicides.

Home by 5 after dropping off Andy Colonna in Arcata. We drove around Eureka via Golf course, Harris Cove, and old Arcata Road - very nice for a change.

Dave brought some enchiladas in for dinner. Bill at a late session this evening - not home for dinner.

Worked on material for Needles.

(4" rain in gauge) ^{left}

Bill got away at 3:00 A.M.

1978

27th day - 338 days follow

Some patchy fog and variable high cloudiness. Otherwise, fair and about 57°F. Dave and I prepared to go into southern Humboldt state parks & Smithe Redwood Preserve near Leggett to photograph vandalism as outlined by park personnel and Save-the-Redwoods League. Lunch in Garberville. Met Ranger Jim Hibbert at 1:30 at Smithe Preserve. Many cars stopping, curious. Vandalism outrageous!

It took all afternoon to locate and document the actual vandalism and resultant necessary cutting of several large trees for safety reasons.

Along The Avenue of the Giants there were many slashes and fresh sawdust from the latest discoveries of vandalism.

Picked up Chinese food as we drove thru Eureka - ate at home.

Dave went home fairly early after playing some records.

I read awhile, leaving lights on for Bill - expected quite late.

Dave + I brought some firewood back with us.

Lovely morning - only a few scattered clouds.

1978

28th day - 337 days follow

At 9:10 I walked Scenic Drive, met Dave + NT near Baker's Beach. Took them home as I had to deliver things to Becky, as promised. Helped Dave as he chainsawed some wood - some for us, too.

Worked around house, then went to Arcata to mail material for needles, around 4.

Greg and Dave here for dinner, turned so we could go to HSV to hear Ray Dasmann, guest speaker for Humboldt Wildlife Society + Kons. Unlimited. Van Duzer Theater packed to the walls.

Dasmann, returned to Calif. after 12 years, noted changes - and new directions, though would not really in too good shape!

Brief visit later at Bill Devall's place. Scott Kruse came in.

Home before 10:30.

1978

29th day - 336 days follow

Lovely morning.

Dave went flying fox with Dick Wilson over his Northshore Lakes property.

Went to Arcata ~~to~~ and Eureka to find a "hot-pot" for Becky.

Bill Devall came by around 5:20.

Went walking at sunset on Indian Beach with Bill, Dave + NT. Dave came by later - after dinner.

Bob Wharton came out around 9 - worked until near-midnight with Bill on article for Off-Belay magazine.

Had long ^{show} talk with Tom Pratte re. Trinidad's planning program.

Started a large collection of washing when afternoon sun came into laundry room.

Stopped at Holly Gibson's briefly to leave Sierra Club cups.

Clear, then foggy, then clearing again.

1978 30th day - 335 days follow

Finished up some laundry work. Dave here to use phone. He was to go flying again. Tom Pratte phoned.

Went to Aresta mid-afternoon on S.C. errands, stopping at NEC and Sue's place.

Stephen Gayle from NEWSWEEK phoned about meeting tomorrow as he was doing story on redwoods, vandalism, etc.

Went for late 5:30-6:00 walk on Indian Beach with Dave & MT.

Bill late getting home. Dinner late. Dave here. Took him home to see film get developed - aerials & ground on log decks - and vandalism - got for S-R-L.

1978 31st day - 334 days follow

Variable cloudiness following light rain

Social Security and Withholding Tax Return Due during late evening hours and in night.

Went for quick walk to Baker's Beach - Met Dave & MT $\frac{1}{2}$ way - Dave drove me home to do some more wood sawing.

Prospective jury duty cancelled today. Did some ironing and sewing and filing.

Went up to Dave's to look at prints, went for very short walk ($\frac{1}{2}$ mile) down Seaside Drive.

Picked up Dave later (6 PM) to go to Enclave Inn to meet Stephen Gayle from Newsweek. We went to Lago's for dinner. A good evening.

Home by 11:30.

Steady rain A.M.

1978 32nd day - 333 days follow

Tacked to NR class at CR 11-12:30.
