Bill brought home a pizza for dinner - early. We ate in fire-warmed living room and watched some TV.

During day I worked at first typed draft of Chapter ExComm minutes, while viewing football games on TV.

45°F. 7:30 A.M. Rain. 1982 4th day - 361 days follow

Rain reported heavy in SF Bay Area - closing highways due to flooding. Began to think of cancelling appt. at Santa Clara Valley Med. Center.

Went to BOS meeting 1:30. Eel River Planning Area was still in leaving process.

Called David in Santa Cruz. He said it was getting "miserable".

Went to North Group Ex Com meeting in Arcata 7-10 p.m. Most officers re-elected. I will continue as secretary.

1982 5th day - 360 days follow 34°F. 8:00 A.M. Frost.

Cancelled trip to Clinic.

Typed up letter to Coastal Comm. Delivered it by 2:30 at Caltrans Bldg. offices. Then spent 3 hrs. at BOS meeting. Humboldt Bay Area Plan was read from 4:30-6. Read statements for Sierra Club.

Called Erika & Bob I would not be ^{travelling} ^{today}. All news centered on massive mud slides which closed 101 north of Golden Gate Bridge and caused many deaths from tumbled homes in Ben Lomond.

37°F. 8 A.M. Variable 1982 8th day - 357 days follow
high cloudiness. Mostly clear and
sunny.

Took things to Becky by
3:30, then stopped to visit
Lisa Ruiz on Mill Creek Road
nearby. We "explored" the property
2 1/2 acres, then had tea. Home
again by 5:15.

Bill has classes on Friday
4-6, so didn't get home until
after 6:30.

Meanwhile, I made a "apple
farm cake", new recipe from
Marie Devall.

Tom here for dinner.

1982 9th day - 356 days follow 39°F. 8 A.M. Clear w/
very high wispy clouds appearing
around mid-day.

Worked around house and did
some washing.

Sawed and split some fire
wood.

Went to VETS before noon -
Dr. David Trabitz (D.V.M.) has taken
over McKinleyville Vet. Service.
Drove around M.K. looking at some
planned projects and the area in general.

37°F. 8 A.M. Some light ¹⁹⁸² and variable cloudiness - and some coastal fog - Otherwise bright, sunny, and warm in mid-day.

Did some washing, then went for walk on beach with Bill between 2-3. Almost no breeze.

Tom watched football game on TV here in morning, then went friends' home to watch later game.

Bill went into town around 3:30. Tom returned around 6:30, as did Bill.

Watched "Salmon on the Run" on NOVA, PBS - filmed on the Klamath River.

Went to Eureka by 1:30. Attended BOS meeting. Issue was appeal of B + B Ranch lane proposal for subdivision. Hearing lasted 3 hrs. Vote will be Feb. 2. LUV, RNP, and Russ Family Inc. among appellants.

Dinner alone at Red Lion Inn. Attended 2 hr. public meeting at City Hall on proposed wood waste, RDF, power plant.

Spoke for Sierra Club at both meetings - on environmental concerns. Home by 10:30.

Had phone call from Damien Custer re. \$ for Hill House lawsuit.

1982 13th day - 352 days follow 37°F. 8 A.M. FAIR.

Left at 10:30 for Ferndale. Met Carlos Benemann, (archeologist) concerned resident, regarding proposed acquisition of 28 acre parcel of ag. land by State Coastal Conservancy. We had lunch at new Mexican food cafe in old Ivanhoe Hotel. Beautiful day. Looked over the parcel twice, entering and leaving town.

Did some house cleaning prior to 1 p.m. arrival of piano tuner, Mr. Swackhammer of Fortuna. He finished by 3:30 and the old upright Heine sounded good again.

Attended Planning Commission meeting from 6:45-10:30 at Court House.

Agriculture Background Study workshop was major item. Home by 11:15. Cold.

1982 15th day - 350 days follow 36°F. 8:00 A.M. FAIR.

Martin Luther King's Birthday

Did some house cleaning. Went to Planning Dept. in Eureka around 2-3. Took things to Becky by 4. Hal phoned around 5 - would be arriving with six persons and fresh crab, etc. for dinner.

Built a fire, made salad dressing before the "invasion".

Some of the gang went to beach while Hal cracked crab, Manda made salad and Bill and I fixed garlic bread.

P.C. joined us at table in dining room and was perfectly behaved.

Tom came in from basket ball game and had some crab and wine (although he had already eaten dinner).

In a large van for field tripping, the gang pulled out at 11:15 for their motel near Arcata.

Tom, Bill and I then watched the Johnny Carson Tonight show.

rain. Left at 8:20 with Bill Revall and friend for S.C. outing in Jed Smith State Park. Total of 10 participated.

Stopped first at Stout Grove. Waters of Mill Creek and Smith River were clear and beautiful.

Drove to trailhead of Boy Scout Trail and with lunches headed out to Fern Falls. Off and on showers. Saw number of birds, including white breasted nuthatch, yellow bellied sapsucker, kinglets, chickadees and leaved jays + ravens.

Lunch at the falls. Rain showers with sunshine on return to cars, about 4 p.m.

Bill & I had sandwiches at friend Dale's small trailer home (where we left him) before driving home - in heavy, heavy rain. Arrived Moorsone 6:45.

 plus leaving a very sharp edge
 to contend with.

Tom returned for the evening.

Talked with Ron Guenther

1982 30th day - 335 days follow

Spent most of day reading literature on dredged material disposal, especially regarding creating islands. Began a draft of a position statement for SC to present to BOS regarding Humboldt Bay Planning Area.

Tom left with Bill around 3:30 - and did not return for the night.

Ate light food - watched TV.

1982 33rd day - 332 days follow 38°F. FAIR.

Greg here briefly on way to
Eureka for new brace appt.
Packed car for trip to bay
area.

Left at 10:30 for errands in Eureka.
Left materials (loaded) at Marine Advisory
office and letters at Coastal Commission office.
Picked up cheeseburger + coffee to eat at over-
look on Humboldt Hill Rd. Beautiful, clear
day. Left vista point 12:15.

Stopped for gasoline in Willits.
Very little traffic until near Santa Rosa.
Drove to Hwy. 116 and headed toward
Sonoma. Hilly rolling hill area,
large ranches and everything green.
Arrived at Wharton's in El Cerrano
around 5:45.

After dinner Erica, Matt and I
drove to Petaluma bus station to
pick up Bob. Once home he
had dinner - we had coffee.
Made travel and car use plans
for tomorrow.

Icy cold. Left around 1982 34th day - 331 days follow

8:30 for Childrens Hospital in Oakland. Erica had Matt in her car while Bot drove mine. Very smoggy and warm in bay area.

Matt went to cardiology clinic and after about 3 hrs. and several tests, results were O.K. Slight murmur; no more. Erica went on to Pacifica where her father resides. Arrived orthopedic clinic 2 hrs. late, but had phoned from Oakland earlier. Had X-ray, blood test (2 of them) saw Dr. Burton and therapist. All O.K. Will not go back for 1 year.

Tim McKay was given "outstanding member" award.

Program was on spotted owls and how USFS uses the species as an "indicator" in preparing management plans. Wonderful slides and good talk by Stephen Layman of Chico.

Home by 11:10. Watched "Tonight" show while.

Earthquake 4:05 A.M.

1982 37th day - 328 days follow 40°F. 8:20 A.M. Variable

high cloudiness. Beautiful day.
Worked around house.

Watched the Trinidad-Clam Beach annual (16th) run from the neighbors' decks from 3:00 to 4:20. Huge number this year - over 1500 participants.

1982 38th day - 327 days follow

Septuagesima Sunday

Did some laundry. Cut some wood.

Lots of clambers around sunset on Moonstone Beach.

Beel in town part of afternoon.

Talked to David in Santa Cruz.

1982 39th day - 326 days follow

Lincoln's Birthday (Monday observance)

Went to BOS meeting at 1:30. Final hearing on Eel River Planning Area of LLP. Discussion focused mainly on determination of what comprises the riparian zone and what uses could occur within that zone.

1982 40th day - 325 days follow

Early lunch. Left for Arecibo to do duplicating prior to attending BOS meeting at 1:30.

Spoke at public time regarding removal of bluff top vegetation above Scenic Drive.

Sat through 2 long planning appeals before the Knox appeal was heard. It began at 3:30 and ended at 5:45. I presented the Audubon & Sierra Club grounds of appeal. It was an active hearing that kept the legal counsel busy.
Home at 6:15.

1982 47th day - 318 days follow 53°F. 7:30 A.M. Rain.

Sorted Redwood Chapter material all morning and wrote some ^{cond} notes.

Gave Tom a ride to Trinidad around 2:30. Saw bluff slides on Scenic Drive.

Tom back for dinner. Watched TV awhile.

.3" rain overnight

FEBRUARY

17

WEDNESDAY

4.4" rain accumulated since Saturday

49°F. 7:30 A.M. Partial clearing. 1982 48th day - 317 days follow

Spent most of day reading, writing and filing after doing a couple loads of laundry.

Rhododendron on terrace flowering fast. Wild currant getting showy also. Cotinus on alders becoming very noticeable and elderberry bushes leafing out quickly.

THURSDAY

18

FEBRUARY

1982 49th day - 316 days follow 49°F. 7:30 A.M.

Did writing and filing of coastal material while searching information for Francis regarding Hill House expansion permit hearings.

Talked with Don Tuttle regarding bluff sliding along Scenic Drive triggered by vegetation removal on bluff top north of Sufferholty Creek. He phoned in response to a BOS order from my appearance Feb. 9.

Went to Planning Commission meeting in Eureka - 2:00 - early adjournment around 9:45. Lois Stone and I enjoyed dessert and coffee at Stanton's. Home by 10:30.

Discussion on "Population" background study. I was the ONLY member of the public who presented oral comments. Most of earlier audience had left.

54°F. 7:30 A.M. Partially cloudy ^{1982 50th day - 315 days follow}

Met Cathy Silva, Diane Marks and Cheryl? at Tsurai Tribal Center at 10 A.M. In Sue car we went to the Kefogle home in Trinidad for a discussion on needed protection for exposed shell middens and burial sites at toe of bluff on Tsurai site. City of Trinidad, Hunt. Land Trust, "Lineal descendants" (Axel Lindgren) NCPA (Diane Marks) and Don Lubenstein from the State Coastal Conservancy ^{at French Spine} were among the interests there. Joy Sundberg alerted me to sit in her place along with Ranheria (Cathy).

Afternoon spent on So. Playa Island. Large sea lion colony and very large land iguanas, colorful, and basking around cactus trees.

Rain squall sent us back to ship an hour earlier than planned. I got soaked! No rain gear. Few photos. Saw "G." hawk.

1982 333rd day - 32 days follow

Prepared for 8 a.m. tour on lovely, fascinating, Bartholomew Island.

Hiked over lava flows and climbed W. stairway 330 ft. to summit for great panoramic view.

Panga returned to take us to beach near Pinnacle Rock.

Snorkeling and swimming - with penguins, sea lions, turtles, tropical fishes. Red, sandy beach. no surf - good swimming.

Returned to ship for lunch - exhausted and somewhat sunburned.
