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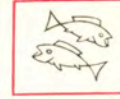

at Moonstone; fog in Eureka area.

Watched part of rose parade on color TV.

Beautiful day, so decided to start knicking away at eucalyptus trunk, long standing on bank s.w. of house. Also pulled a lot of unwanted ground-cover that chokes everything ("ivy-like").

Bill and I took walk on beach with Charlie Bower, who showed up just as we were leaving.

"Lots and lots" of people at Moonstone. Parking lot full.

Took many slides of Pilot Point.

Tom tried surfing from 3:30 - 4:30 - caught a few waves.

"Clean and dried" for dinner; tired from chopping and sawing. In bed by 9:30.

43°F. 7:00 A.M. Fair. 1981 2nd day - 363 days follow

Worked on material for coast.
Got packet of info. ready for Kirk
Denver in S.E. Sacramento office.

Filed much accumulated "loose"
material, trying to empty numerous
boxes taking up floor space in
"conservation room".

Typed rough draft to Parks Comm.
re. Pilot Point project.

Bill went to Arcata around
2, returning around 6 - having
found Dix and Lee at home.

Took things to Bechy before 5.

Tom staying in town for
movie.

1981 3rd day - 362 days follow 59°F. 6:00 A.M. Cloudy,
rain began at Moonstone 8:00 A.M.

Took Tom to L-P mill at Big Lagoon
by 6:30. Many lights from fishing boats
off Big Lagoon spit made rosy glow
in low hanging clouds.

Worked on Sierra Club statement for
State Parks Commission leaving Jan. 9.

Talked with Sue, Julie Verman,
Barbara Kelly and a Mrs. Hall in
Eureka. All calls regarding to land use
problems. Also, Mark Hoffart phoned.

Went to Arcata for duplicating, then to
main Eureka post office by 3 p.m.

Did 2 washer loads of laundry in Arcata.
Relaxed rest of day, once home.

Tom away for dinner - phoned first.

Started "Xmas" letter.

SUNDAY

45° F. 5:30 A.M. Clear with 1981 4th day - 361 days follow

some high ^{Epiphany} cloudiness at periods during day. Took Tom to L-P mill at Big Lagoon by 6:30. More boats off the spit today. Lovely crescent moon and bright morning sky in view from Big Lagoon as I drove away from the mill.

Took photos of Pilot Point before noon.

Worked around Louise. Took down Xmas tree decorations. And with it a little housecleaning.

Lovely day.

Had a nice bath and Shampoo, then watched TV awhile.

Called David on this, his 60th birthday; also talked to Jeanette, who is progressing well.

1981 5th day - 360 days follow 43° F. 7:20 A.M.

Had a "picnic" when putting Xmas decorations away in attic after lunch. Began going through boxes stored since 1968. Came up with boxes, jewelry, "goodies."

Tom slept until noon.

Took film to Accata late afternoon. First dropped Tom in Trinidad to do his laundry.

Worked on personal phone list. Had a call from Barbara Kelly re. Her appeal to State Com.

41°F. ^{7:30 A.M.} Clear here; patchy fog elsewhere. 1981 6th day - 359 days follow
 worked on Fresh Group Ex Com minutes.
 After lunch, began 2 loads of washing.

1981 7th day - 358 days follow 46°F. 7:30 A.M. Beautiful sunrise. Considerable cloudiness.

Tom returned around 8:30 and headed for bed.

At 1:30 I met with Sandra Corcoran and Jack Ople in McKinleyville to go over the proposed sewer treatment plant area north of Hill Rd, west of highway 101. We walked through pastureland, skirting the timbered area (very thick) to the bluff overlooking Mad River. Then we walked north along the old R.R. right of way - the new coastal trail route. Then we drove to end of Kelly road, south of Murray Road, walked over the logged over Knox parcel (encountered H. Knox at his new buildings, with high fences, thick walls, etc - horrible person, Hollywood north!) Walked to deep ravine at edge of property -
 Went to Cooper Gulch Rec. Center in Eureka by 7 p.m. for Humboldt Bay Area planning community workshop.
 Home by 10:20.

51°F. 7:20 A.M. Cloudy.

Did some washing.

Went to Acosta, then Eureka before
4 to do errands. Planning Commission
meeting, special to hear Eel River Area
Plan at 4 p.m. at Clark Complex.
Meeting short after decision of
Commission to not hear any more
LCP plans until LUV lawsuit
cleared!

Joined Lois Stone at a LUV
potluck dinner at Barbara Smith's
home. We left before their meeting
to attend the regular planning Comm
meeting at the Court House. It
lasted from 7-11:30.

8th day - 357 days follow

1981 9th day - 356 days follow 48°F. 7:30 A.M.

Did some laundry work - early.
No class for Bill today, only
a meeting.
Typed up ExCom minutes summary
for Redwood Needles - for mailing.
Took things to Becky before 5.

46°F. 6:00 A.M. Cool rain ¹⁹⁸¹ 10th day - 355 days follow ocean, high tide.

Took Tom to mill at Big Lagoon by 6:30. He stayed in Trinidad afterwards.

Bill went into Arenal in late afternoon.

Lead coastal material - Cool. Had fire going after doing some house cleaning to keep warm.

Tom's father phoned around 5.

Spent evening going over coastal material.

¹⁹⁸¹ 11th day - 354 days follow 45°F. 7:30 A.M. Clear, but some patchy fog and high clouds. Took a T-shirt, sandwich & coffee to Tom when I picked him up on Stagecoach Rd. at 6:15 A.M. Got him to mill by 6:30.

Drove north to Orich, watched break of dawn from near Redwood Creek mouth; Fresh-water lagoon. Fishing boats close in to surf. Looked at proposed coastal projects - south of Orich & highway north of Big Lagoon bridge.

Home for late dinner - around 9.

then hit the road for Santa Rosa.
Nice drive. Arrived at Julie Kerran's
place about 6:45. (Had picked up
hamburger & milkshake from Willits.)

Julie went through the slide
presentation as to be shown at
NCNRCC meeting tomorrow.

In my sleeping bag before
10.

SATURDAY

JANUARY

1981 17th day - 348 days follow Overcast. Some light rain.

Julie and I got to Sonoma State Univ.
at Phoenix Park for 10 A.M. NCNRCC
meeting. Large attendance - 4 from
Redwood Chapter.

Julie presented Sinkyone issue, with
slides. I covered film making in
State Parks and Red Mountain (in Ron
Quentner's absence). Gave luncheon.
Talked to Kirk Neuner about Trinidad
and Land Trust problems.

Meeting was intense, good, and
raised spirits of most, in spite of
bleak 4 years ahead under ~~current~~
administration. Adjourned 5 p.m.

Went to Kay Clegg's home. Snatched

Afterwards spent couple of hours
just talking - at Karp's place.

Watched some TV after Bill Sevall's visit around 5:30-6:00.

1981 19th day - 346 days follow 52°F. 7:30 A.M. Much wind.

Rain, hard during night, decreased. 16 flowers out on rhododendron.

Power outage 7:45 A.M. — 12:30 p.m. Used camp stove & kerosene lantern for breakfast convenience.

Worked at sorting out and disposing of lots of extraneous conservation material. Sorted color slides.

Dinner around 8.

Grey arrived around 10:15 as I was taking Tom to work at Big Lagoon mill. Clear, beautiful moonlight. Had to wait for the "lagoon herd" of elk to get off the roadway. We halted a bit to watch them. Same thing returning. They moved single file from one marshy area, across the road to another marshy area. Wonderful sight.

Slept in loft. Gave Grey my bed.

1981

21st day - 344 days follow ~~54~~ F. 8:30 A.M.

Wind increased as day progressed.
Walked to Moonstone Beach around 10:30.
High tide around 11:30 (7.3 ft.) Then
walked to Luffenbultz Beach area. Stood
on stairway, walked out near beach,
for exciting views of exploding breakers,
all the shoreline battered by crashing,
thundering, wind driven, huge waves.

No rain fell during the time I was out.
No jacket needed. Exceedingly warm.

Hert Pierce (7+6) came by for
loan of a camera to photograph Little
River's flooded condition. I went with
him to take photos. Crannell Road
flooded - passable, but brakes got wet.

One Rhododendron in full (red) flower!

Friend of Tom's came for TV set before noon (super bowl day).

Watched part of superbowl game on small black + white TV set.

Bill went off somewhere in afternoon.

50°F. 7:30 A.M.

1981 26th day - 339 days follow

Went to NEC by 8 for brief meeting regarding Wildlife Refuge and the Humboldt Bay Area Planning. Home by 10:15. Took Tom to Big Lagoon mill.

JANUARY

about 4" rain.

1981 29th day - 336 days follow 41°F. Variable cloudiness.

Showers. Cold. Stayed near heater or fire most of day - reading new magazines.

Call at 5 from Coastal Commission staff in S.F. Appeal on Pilot Point not valid! Western Union had NOT hand delivered telegram before 5 P.M. Dec. 26. -- only phoned!

Watched some good TV on PBS. In bed by 11:30.

38°F. 8:00 A.M. Variable cloudiness. 1981 30th day - 335 days follow

Worked around house. Chopped some wood.

Dropped Tom and laundry in Trinidad shortly after 1 p.m. on way to Ensenada.

Picked up chair and stool from Big Dipper, and Bill's Xmas slacks from Johnsons (having been Lenned).

Took things to Becky before 5. Tom went to basketball game at HSV.

Bill Devall in briefly after running on beach - planning on Clam Beach seen tomorrow.

Watched some TV programs, then headed for bed by 11:30.

1981 31st day - 334 days follow 38°F. 6:00 A.M. Took

Tom to Big Lagoon mill by 6:30. Returned home by 7 to pick up Bill - he was STILL in bed! Roused him to leave, had to get his camera (on campus). Managed to get to King Salmon by 8 for whale watching cruise on "Moku", a charter boat.

Dressed warmly, 14 of us enthusiastically scanned the water from Humboldt Bay entrance to near Trinidad - offshore about 5 miles.

Sports, dine, rolls, were exciting at close viewing - maybe the same whale, but the beauty of it all - and the suspense after sounding, was wonderful. Waters calm. Cool, but warm in full sunshine on return trip. Snow capped ridges made beautiful backdrop to coastal scenery.

Many crab boats still out, but ~~boats~~ ^{both} nearly empty - mostly "fished out." Saw harbor seal and porpoises.

Late, big breakfast at Stanton's around 2 p.m. Home by 3:15, Clam Beach run finished. Hundreds on beach at finish line at Strawberry Creek.

Tom in Trinidad for evening. Greg and Jim Tucker used sleeping bags in living room.

Took Tom to Big Lagoon by 6:30. Lagoon low, having breached recently. Ancient moon in eastern sky.

FEBRUARY

1981 33rd day - 332 days follow 39°F. 7 A.M.

Social Security and Withholding Tax Return Due

Cold!
Spent most of day telephoning - regarding coastal matters.

Tom checked out surf at Camel Rock after 3 P.M.

42°F. 8:00 A.M. Variable Cloudiness ¹⁹⁸¹ 34th day - 331 days follow

Mostly clear.

Did some telephoning regarding Coastal Commission reappointments.

Did 2 loads of washing. Split some wood. Cut some grass. Lovely afternoon out of doors.

Bath + shampoo before taking Tom to Big Lagoon by 10:30.

41°F. 7:30 A.M. 35th day - 330 days follow

Tom returned around 10:30 and headed for bed.

Phoned Coastal Conservancy (Tom Mikkelsen) and Trust for Public Lands (Jenny Girard) in Bay area regarding threat of development on Pilot Point.

Met Del Norte's Ted and Chris Souza, Jerry Keger, Bill Boyer - and Merrill Bytheriver - at the Waterfront sandwich shop in Eureka - for lunch.

Planned comments for discussions with Caltrans District personnel regarding proposed Hwy. 199 improvements.

Meeting was congenial, hopefully productive, and lasted 2 hrs. Home by 4.

Went to Trinidad Area Plan (CAL) workshop 7-10 at City Hall in Trinidad. Approx. 50 persons in attendance. As sub-committee member I helped conduct the workshops. Tom went with me.

45°F. 7:45 A.M. Storm 1981 36th day - 329 days follow

clouds clearing after night of rain.

Cool. Stayed in side mostly working on conservation matters.

Much coastal material to go over for meeting next week.

1981 37th day - 328 days follow 39°F. 7:30 A.M.

worked around Louse. Reel coastal material.

Herb Pierce, and daughter (on day off), arrived around noon - returning color slides. We tacked, along with Tom (who got up around 12:30) for nearly 2 hours.

Good slides of Bell Springs road and environs. Prepared for after dinner slide show.

Took things to Becky before 5. Left Tom in Trinidad - would find way home later - for dinner.

Showed RNP slides, Bell Springs Mtn, and Touris Harland's Landing slides after dinner and before "Dallas" at 10 on TV.

News that Mt. St. Helens is rumbling again.

41° F. 6:00 A.M. Clear. 1981 38th day - 327 days follow

Took Tom to L-P mill at Big Lagoon by 6:30.

Sorted some color slides.

Went to Acata recycling center after lunch.

Put 1st coat of "French polish" on newly stripped old chair.

Warm, beautiful afternoon.

Many people on beaches.
Ocean extremely calm.

Talked awhile with neighbor Don Novell.

Bill split firewood.

1981 39th day - 326 days follow 45° F. 6:00 A.M. CLOUDY.

Took Tom to L-P mill at Big Lagoon by 6:30.

Did some washing.

about 43°F. 7:00 a.m. 1981 40th day - 325 days follow

Lincoln's Birthday (Monday observance)

Went to Arents for copying and shopping

Greg and corps person Dave Kani arrived at 5:30. We had dinner at North town Park, then went to Van Klee's for North Group Excom. Meeting began at 7:10 and adjourned at 9:30.

1981 41st day - 324 days follow 47°F. 7:00 a.m.

FEBRUARY

11

WEDNESDAY

53°F. 7:30 A.M. Rain 1981 42nd day - 323 days follow

Did some washing, ironing, and packed 3 separate brief cases for meetings over several days.

Left tie at service station in Eureka at 6 p.m. Dinner at Red Lion before 7 p.m. meeting of CAC at Clark Complex. Quorum present. Many from Trinidad on hand to discuss CAC review and changes were made. Walkout by de Platin & Quiggly to disallow vote on riparian buffer width and minimum parcel sizes north Trinidad and West Haven areas.

Bill brought Tom to meeting for access presentation, which was submitted to planners for consideration. They recovered my spare time before station's midnight closing time.

Meeting was wild! Quorum returned reluctantly. Adjourned about 12.

Followed Lois Stone home to throw sleeping bag on couch for a few hours. Couldn't get to sleep ^{early}, thinking about the meeting and people's behavior.

patches of fog. Awake at 5:50. Left Eureka 5:50. Drove directly (non-stop) to Ft. Bragg. Coast was BEAUTIFUL, following heavy rains for 2 days. Breakfast at 9:10 - quick-gas stop, then on to Pt. Arena. Arrived at Regional Coastal Commission meeting (Civic Club) at 10:20, just in time for Shelter Cove permit hearing (which was recommended for denial). Supported denial. Permit on bluff denied.

Joined Peter Reimuller and Ron Guenther for field trip to Bowling Ball beach area, where huge home proposed above beach. Large number made site inspection before lunch. Took number of slides of fascinating Bowling Ball beach.

Public hearing 2:20 - 5:40 on Elliot's ^{possible} development. Packed meeting room. Heavy protest against loss of access. Much good testimony. Strange 6 & 4 vote for approval with conditions.

Drove Hwy. 20 to Willits. Had large breakfast type meal at 12:00 NOON.

Hailed Alan Kinsman (at stop sign) near Hospital, near Julie Verran's place.

Walked back to emergency room where Alan removed woodtick embedded in left shoulder - unreachable for me. Pure luck to run across him.

In most states when a Holiday falls on a Saturday, the preceding Friday is observed as the holiday. If the holiday occurs on a Sunday, the Monday following is usually observed. Holidays in some states are only by common consent, or when appointed by the Governor, and not by legislative enactment.
