Power returned after (only) 20 minutes.

Linda A. phoned about RNHA meeting.

Clearing in afternoon -

Phone calls - Lynn Lyon regarding conservation committee minutes;

Jody Vidauer, about April 3 meeting in Ukiah at American Savings Bank.

Rivers rising to near flood stage.

David B. phoned - all wet, but O.K. in Santa Cruz.

Bill Ehorn phoned about staff program.

Bill Craft phoned in late evening - here for a week at Kane Rd. cabin.

Watched TV coverage of inaugural balls.

37° F. 5:30 A.M.

A few errands in Acreata on way home - Bill had gone to Trinidad for a few groceries.

Quiet evening - reading and some TV.

54°F. 7:25 A.M.

1993 30th day - 335 days follow

16-18 quail - house finches and 1 golden crown sparrow added to "usuals".

Attended Westhaven Community Dev. Council meeting at Tim McKay's home 10-12. Good committee reports on fund raising, negotiations and water-digging. By-laws com. report postponed. Next meeting Feb. 13.

Bill took usual walk - mid-day - then went into town later in afternoon. Very balmy. Lots of people on the beach.

Read conservation materials and new magazines.

Showery --- very light. Mostly sunny.

Lois came by with latest draft of by-laws at 10:20 - for my review and corrections.

Did some ironing before lunch.

Bill took usual walk.

Marianne phoned about Sunday's SL program.

Settled down for several hours after lunch going over by-laws with a "fine-toothed comb".

Phoned HSC Center Arts to reserve tickets for performance at 8 - American Indian Dance Group.

Lois picked things up around 5:30.

Early dinner.

Sell-out crowd for program. We had good seats in the balcony.

Dancers were exciting - colorful - and extremely skillful, especially the hoop dance performer. The audience included a LOT of native Americans, as one would expect. Response was wild, noisy, enthusiastic.
